<b>List of topics covered</b>	The course will cover a wide range of topics concerning <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- alternative energy sources</li> <li>- renewable energies</li> <li>- environmental and energy policy</li> <li>- energy savings</li> </ul>
<b>Teaching format</b>	Communicative approach: students are expected to actively engage in the activities in class and in the analysis of texts, to participate in discussions and to contribute with short class presentations. It's also planned a homework in form of a written production. The papers will be corrected and discussed with the students during the lessons.

<b>Learning outcomes</b>	<p>To understand and be able to use the distinctive syntactic features and terminology of Italian journalism, specialized periodicals, and Italian culture; to write clearly and accurately, with appropriate register and style; to give presentations in the target language.</p> <p><u>Knowledge and understanding:</u> Understanding of journalistic and academic language and style with a special focus on engineering science.</p> <p><u>Applying knowledge and understanding:</u> Communicating, both orally and in writing, using language and style that are appropriate</p>
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	<p>to relevant workplaces and language certification requirements.</p> <p><u>Making judgments and Communication skills:</u> Participating in discussions on various topics, especially within the fields of energy policy</p> <p><u>Learning skills</u> Ability to pursue autonomous learning</p>
<b>Assessment</b>	<p>Final exam: consisting of a written exam and an oral presentation during the course. The students are asked to give the papers on topics discussed during the course before the written test.</p> <p>There will be individual writing activities to be done during the class or as homework.</p> <p>Non attending students must contact the Lecturer during the course in order to decide the topics and the oral presentations modality.</p>
