RESEARCH

Research interests

I have done long term ethnographic research research on nomadism, marriage and death among the Sinti in northern Italy (3 years). I am also interested in begging practices as forms of gift economies, and in

ethnographic archival research inspired by the mnemonic practices of my interlocutors and postcolonial theories about silenced voices in the archive. Together with my colleagues at the Malinowski Forum, we are researching on the traces in alpine anthropology and ethnographic research of Malinowski and Elsie Masson's stay in South Tyrol from 1922-1934.

More recently, I have been focusing on alpine semi-natural grasslands, for which I co-lead the LEAD-SNF project "Global pastures". In collaboration with ecologists and designers, we consider grass as a more-than-human subject through which we get a different perspective on changes in human practices and landscapes embedded in local and global networks.

Ethnographic field research

My current ethnographic research focuses on pastoralists, questions about the return of the wolf and the value of pasture grass in the Eastern Alps. My approach is that of a multispecies ethnography, linking to debates on ontology and multispecies research in anthropology, art and ecology.

In my ethnographic fieldwork with semi-nomadic Sinti I was fully immersing in their semi-nomadic life, which I shared for three years (1997-2000) living in a caravan. This was followed by ethnographic research on Sinti schooling in northern Italy (9 months, 2001-2002) and ethnographic archival work following Sinti mnemonic practices. In my research (15 months) on European institutions (European Commission Brussels and Council of Europe Strasbourg) as well as in public institutions in Italy (Rome, Bolzano), I focused on studying the making of European Roma integration policies in the sense of "studying up" (2014-2017). Commissioned by the Cultural Department of the Province of South Tyrol in 2008, I ethnographically explored the processes of meaning-making and the experiences of women who are members of sub-national political movements in the region of Tyrol.
