- Summary of current research and scholarship

My research investigates a controversial topic in the world of contemporary design: the relationship between design practices and the possibility of constructing, through those practices, a critique of the social reality in which they operate, in order to modify the conditions of possibilities of that reality and then produce some kind of change. I'm currently focusing on two different areas. The first refers to the growing relevance gained by infographics as a form of language and visualization employed in the dissemination of specific forms of knowledge to a broader public. The second area refers to the increasing presence of digital technologies – and especially technologies employing what is commonly called Artificial Intelligence – within design practices and the realm of visual culture.

- Summary of research and scholarship during the previous five years
During its first years (PhD thesis) the research has been developed mainly as a bibliographical investigation. The research question was to define and frame the concept of criticism and critical practices in the field of design. This meant a critical and historical reading of the theoretical discussions that have crossed the discipline in the last decades, but also a confrontation with different frameworks and theories arisen within other fields – aesthetics, art history, cultural, visual and media studies, sociology, philosophy, etc. During the second year I started to analyze and collect different case studies, approaches and projects that, according to the first theoretical phase, has been included within the field of critical design practices.

- Summary of significant achievements in research and scholarship
In 2018 the research activity merged into a publishing project called *Design&Conflicts*, in collaboration with the cultural association Krisis Publishing (www.krisispublishing.com). *Design&Conflicts* is designed as a series of books focusing on the relationship between design practices and the representation and articulation of conflicts. Each volume selects and collects papers and essays concerning a particular area of critical and political design. The first book includes contributions by Chantal Mouffe, Carl DiSalvo, John B.

Harley, Jeremy W. Crampton, Johanna Drucker and Peter Hall. Published in May 2019 in 500 copies, *Design&Conflicts. Mouffe, DiSalvo, Harley, Crampton, Drucker, Hall*, has been included in the bibliography of the course “Decisione e progettazione per il futuro”, run by professor Simona Morini (Iuav University of Venice, MA Design del prodotto e della comunicazione visiva, 2019/20).
