

Curriculum Vitae (short version)

Gerhard Sammer studied several subjects in Teaching Education (music, mathematics, IT, instrumental teaching) and orchestral conducting at the University of Innsbruck, the Tyrolean conservatory and the University of Mozarteum Salzburg (Austria) followed by a PhD in Music Pedagogy. He taught in different school types and worked as a staff scientist before he got professor for music education at the University for Music in Würzburg (Germany), which led to numerous publications. In the function of the dean for studies and board member of the international accreditation institution MusiQuE he is strongly involved in quality assurance and university development as well as in several international projects; until 2019 he was president of the European Association for Music in Schools (EAS). From 2020-2022 he was also guest/visiting professor at the Free University of Bozen (Italy).

His work as free lanced profession in orchestral conducting brought him after years of assisting famous conductors (like Nikolaus Harnoncourt, Peter Gülke, Salvador Mas Conde, etc.) the chance to work in several European countries with different orchestras (Germany, Austria, Italy, France, Poland) and worked with numerous brilliant artists / soloists (eg. Musicians from the Vienna Philharmonic and other orchestras). Since 25 years he is in charge if the artistic director and chief conductor of the tyrolean chamber orchestra "Innstrumenti". He led 200 first performances of orchestra pieces, which is also documented in several broadcast recordings (RAI, Italy / ORF, Austria / BR, Germany) and CDs. He also designed and moderated many children´s concerts. Many concert recordings (also of pupils concerts) are also easily available via the youtube channel of the tyrolean chamber orchestra.
