Small bio

Architect, she received her PhD in History of Architecture and Urbanism at Politecnico di Torino with a thesis on the relations between architecture and public institutions in Brazil's modernism under the lens of Lucio Costa's trajectory. She has been Assistant Researcher (AR) at the Platform Cultural Heritage Cultural Production of the Faculty of Design and Art, Free University of Bozen-Bolzano (2020-24), where she has served as co-I of the interdisciplinary research project "Written in the Landscape. Places, Traces, and Memories of the World War I in the Sesto Dolomites" and participated in the research project "Curating Bolzano's Fascist Legacy. A Sustainable Approach to a City's Dissonant Heritage". Since 2010 she has taught courses of History of Architecture, Urban Planning and Landscape History and Theory at Politecnico di Milano and since 2013 she is member of the editorial board of the architectural magazine "Lotus International". She received the habilitation as associate professor in Restoration and History of Architecture. She curated several exhibitions and published extensively on contemporary architecture, urban planning and landscape, with special reference to Brazilian modernism and the circulation of architectural ideas and models between Europe and the Americas, and the disciplinary encroachments between architecture, arts and landscape in the contemporary debate. Recently she has been devoting her interest to heritagization processes and to heritage concepts and practices. Her research have been presented in Europe, the United States, Canada and Brazil in the framework of international seminars and conferences. She is author of the monographic volumes *Un progetto di mediazione. Lucio Costa fra tutela del patrimonio e nuova architettura* (Maggioli, 2014) and *Architecture as Civil Commitment. Lucio Costa's Modernist Project for Brazil* (Routledge, 2019).
