Designer & founder of "bada&bou"

"I want to challenge the boundaries between various creative fields... might it be design and architecture or furniture and toys - in order to create meaningful design that lasts."

Olivia Herms is a German/French industrial designer and founder raised in Berlin. After her master's degree in industrial design at ENSCI (Ecole Nationale De Création Industrielle) in Paris in 2004, she moved to Stockholm to collaborate with architect & design office Claesson Koivisto Rune.

Olivia Herms worked on a large variety of projects ranging from product design (Iittala, Wästberg), handcraft (Carpets for MMF), jewellery and interior design (Sfera shop) and had the chance to be involved in several larger architectural projects.

2009 she moved back to Germany and joined the Industrial Design Studio KGID of Konstantin Grcic. For 10 years she was responsible as designer and project leader for a wide range of projects for international companies and institutions.

Commissions in the fields of furniture design (Flötotto, Emeco, Vitra), interior architecture (Parrish Art Museum in collaboration with Herzog & de Meuron, German Pavilion at the Venice Biennale) and scenography & fashion (Richard Siegal, Prada) enriched her multi-disciplinary approach.

In parallel she opened her own studio (Studio OH) in 2013 to collaborate with companies such as Swedish brass company Skultuna and German furniture company Acapulco Design.

After having gained large experience as a designer she continued her adventure in 2019 by launching her own brand "bada&bou" with a collection of timeless play furniture for kids. Today, "bada&bou" is an established brand in the kids design sector in Europe and has received the German Design Award and Junior Design Award amongst others.
