Research and scholarships

UR-Beira: a project funded by the Italian Agency for Development Cooperation (AICS) in Mozambique and coordinated by Veneto Region, aimed at strengthening the emergency health services managed by local authorities in the district of Beira, with a particular focus on obstetric and pediatric emergencies

Main responsibilities: Development of a Cost-Effectiveness Analysis of the intervention.

Main expected research output: through qualitative and quantitative methodology we are investigating the correct and efficient functioning of the emergency system developed by CUAMM – Doctors with Africa with a focus on task bottlenecks across different phases of the project (e.g, different distribution of resources and decision rights throughout a 4-year implementation period).

Ashoka SEs, Cross-Sector Partnerships and empowerment of beneficiaries (early stage): based on a dataset elaborated from Ashoka, we are studying the effects of cross-sector partnerships involving Ashoka Social social enterprises in terms of material and/or psychological empowerment for beneficiaries. We expect to use both quantitative and qualitative methods.

Digitalization and the third sector: based on a series of third mission activities realized with Save the Children – Italia (StC), we aim to

develop an in-depth case study analysis to better understand on one hand, how StC succeeded in its digital transformation, and, on the other hand, which are the biggest challenges NGOs face when undertaking the digital transformation.

 WISE work integration Social Entreprises Digitalization: applied research regional project financed under FSE funds to study and design new work integration opportunities enabled by digital technologies.
