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## Short Bio

I received my PhD in Linguistics (2004) at the University of Pavia, where I acquired a background in theoretical linguistics and sociolinguistics.

My first scientific interest, as a post-doc researcher, was centered around contact-induced linguistic variation in migratory social contexts. At the same time, I started to explore different methodological approaches to the study of speech variation, combining experimental methods with advanced techniques of quantitative analysis. For this reason, after taking a tenured researcher position at the Free University of Bolzano I set up a laboratory of experimental phonetics (ALPS) and I specialized in **articulatory phonetics**. In the lab, I mainly use the ultrasound tongue imaging technique to study the **bilingual speech** of Italian-German speakers.

Most of the research I currently do focuses on **quantitative analysis of natural speech**, with the aim of understanding (a) the interaction between linguistic and social sources of speech variation (b) the role that such interaction plays in a theory of phonological competence.

## 4 Research and Scholarship

### 4.1 Summary of Main Research Directions

My past and present research interests are centered around the variability of speech. In particular, in the years following my PhD, I conducted research in the field of sociolinguistics of variation, working mainly on language contact and bilingualism in a migratory context. From this line of research I also developed my interest in the quantitative analysis of the social networks as a tool for understanding language variation.

My current research focuses rather on variability in speech production from a Laboratory Phonology perspective. I am interested in studying and developing models that include variability as a component of phonological competence. This line of research is divided into two domains: sociophonetics and interface between phonetics and phonology.

The first domain includes studies on the articulation of rhotic sounds in Italian-German bilingual speakers. The more general aim is to study the relationship between the structure of personal social networks and the realization of rhotics. To carry out these studies I used the technique of Ultrasound Tongue Imaging and for this reason, together with Lorenzo Spreafico, I set up a speech science laboratory (ALPS) at the Free University of Bozen-Bolzano.

Research in the second domain focuses on the study of the interaction between the continuous dimension of speech and the discrete and abstract nature of phonological categories. In this direction I have conducted research on the variable nature of laryngeal contrasts in Tyrolean and I also started to get interested in the Exemplar Theory.

The languages that are the object of my research are mainly Italian, German and Tyrolean dialect but I also work on Ladin and Sardinian.

The need to solve problems of data analysis has triggered a parallel methodological scientific activity. Related to this activity is the research on methods for the quantitative analysis of lingual movements. For this reason I have conducted research in the field of functional data analysis (together with Simone Vantini and Alessia Pini of the Mathematics Department of Politecnico di Milano) and, more generally, of multivariate analysis.
