

## Remuneration

The Free University of Bozen/Bolzano will remunerate contract teaching staff for lectures, seminars, tutorials and workshops the gross hourly amounts shown in the table below, which are inclusive of any travel and/or accommodation costs.

1) If a course is split, with the exception of tutorials, language courses and workshops, the hourly remuneration for any additional course to the first is equal to 60% of the remuneration for the first course.

2) Assistance provided for students who are undertaking their dissertation for their undergraduate degree (*bachelor*), master's programme and specialisation is paid at 60% of the hourly teaching rate for up to 5 hours per student for the undergraduate dissertation (*bachelor*) and specialisation and a maximum of 10 hours per student for the master's programmes. This remuneration also includes participation as a member of the final exam commission.

3) For work connected to the end-of-course exams (written and/or oral) and the participation as a commission member for the final exam, a maximum of three hours will be remunerated per exam session scheduled by the School.
